Hand hygiene: an essential gesture

By following the barrier gestures recommended in the current pandemic, hand washing frequency has multiplied by 3, and the length of time taken to wash hands has increased by 50%. There is an urgent need to install taps systematically in all public places, especially in healthcare facilities. Theses taps must be quick to install, comfortable to use and easy to clean.

DELABIE, European market leader for water controls and sanitary fittings for public and commercial places, has been offering a wide range of stainless steel sanitary ware for several years, all of which meet these requirements.

A practical and hygienic stainless steel washbasin

Lighter than a composite material washbasin, DELABIE's Hygienic washbasin in stainless steel is easy to install. Its small size means that it can be installed anywhere: treatment rooms, corridors, doctors' practices, dental practices, etc. Its high backsplash allows a wall mounted tap/mixer to be installed and avoids splashes on the wall. Its deep basin ensures comfortable hand washing.

Stainless steel has long been used in hospitals and professional kitchens and is a must for hygiene as it is bacteriostatic. The smooth surface of this washbasin and its rounded inner edges limit bacterial niches and facilitate cleaning.

This hand-washing basin is eco-friendly. Stainless steel is 100% recyclable. Lightweight, its transport requires fewer resources.

A stainless steel washbasin designed for hygiene

The DELABIE Hygiène washbasin in stainless steel is delivered with a DELABIE HYGIÉNA drain (ref. 6110). This drain has a concave grid, without central screw, which avoids water retention, the catching of residues and reduces bacterial niches.

The DELABIE Hygiene stainless steel washbasin is available with various tap hole configurations to ensure that a DELABIE tap or mixer can be installed to suit your needs, for example:

- an electronic BINOPTIC tap, ref. 379ENC: the absence of manual contact avoids the transmission of germs by hands and the periodic rinsing avoids the stagnation of water in the pipes;
- a Securitouch sequential mixer, ref. 2641: compliant with NF Medical requirements, it allows opening and closing on cold water for increased anti-scald safety;
- a thermostatic mixer with removable spout, ref. H9614P: possibility of installing a BIOCLIP spout in stainless steel, a disposable spout in Hostaform® or a BIOFIL spout with an anti-legionella and anti-germ filter.

These 3 recommended taps to be installed on the DELABIE Hygiene washbasin in stainless steel have a water jet that does not fall on the bung (tested in our laboratories) which avoids back contamination.

The DELABIE Hygiene washbasin in stainless steel therefore offers many advantages for hygienic and comfortable hand washing.
